



GENERAL INFORMATION & DATES TO REMEMBER

Firstly – a big welcome to all **NEW & Returning Coaches, Managers, Parents and Players** to the 2010 Winter Season.

Please take the time to read this **General Information & Dates to Remember Sheet** .

REGISTRATION MONEY

All Registration Money **MUST** be fully paid by the first game of competition on **April 17 & 18**. A player who has not paid their registration money will not be able to take the field as they will not be covered by insurance. This also includes all Games Money for seniors. If you are having difficulty in paying your registration please call Paul Boyd on 4578 2849 to make alternative arrangements.

WET WEATHER

Either the **Coach or Manager will be informed** by the Committee if a game is cancelled due to wet weather or the grounds are closed for training. All players are to assume the game is on until they are contacted by their Coach or Manager. The teams who are playing first will be contacted first.

SAFETY FIRST

The **Climbing of Trees, on Goal Posts, Fences or Benches** or any other building is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**. If any person (coach, manager, parent or player) sees a dangerous act or carelessness - please ask the child to stop or inform a committee member.

ID BADGES

All Committee/Grounds members, **COACHES and MANAGERS MUST** wear a **Lanyard ID Badge** at all games. This is a rule from Nepean and ID Badges will be given out to those concerned.

GAME SHIRTS

Game Shirts **MUST ONLY TO BE WORN FOR THE GAME...** No player is to wear the shirt home or around the grounds unless playing. Shirts must be kept together in the team kit bag.

BRAG BOOKS (Player ID)

Coaches and Managers are asked to take extra care with the players Brag Books (ID Cards). If the cards are lost it will cost the players \$15 to replace any missing cards – and **they are not permitted to play** without them.

CODES OF CONDUCT

The **Codes of Conduct Booklet** will be distributed to every coach, manager and player. Coaches and Managers should make sure that every player reads and understands the rules in the booklet provided. Please have every player sign the back of a booklet once it has been read to them.

PUBLICITY REPORTS

ALL managers are encouraged to take the time to write a publicity report each week to go into the Gazette. The report sheets will be put into your team folders.
