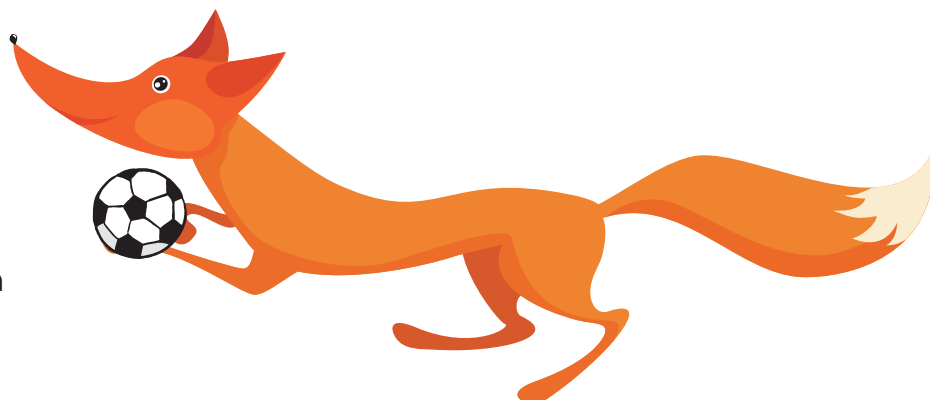

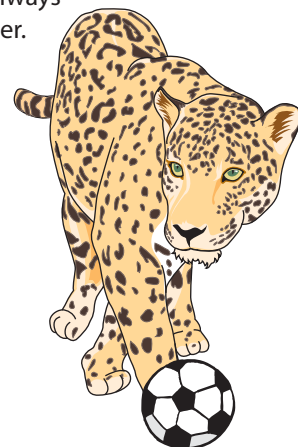

Bryce Rielly: Excellent little man, future star! Has fantastic ball skills and I can only see him improving as time goes on. A driven young player.

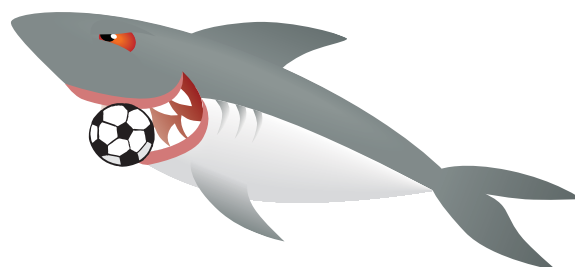
Leo Berry: He has improved out of sit! Leo's attention to the game and involvement this season has shown me how quickly these guys can pick things up, fantastic job!

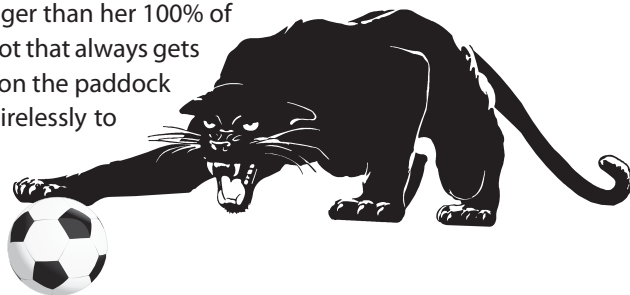
