

Here is a run down on our season....

2018 saw mixed results, with some teams feeling the struggle more so than others. Quite successful were our U12/2's who last year won U12 Div 4. They were promoted this year and will now gain entry to Div 1 in 2019 as they have become Comp Winners two years in a row! They also made it to the Quarter Finals of the Junieur Nepean Cup. Fantastic Effort!

Our, what is becoming legendary, Pink Day was a resounding success again this year. We sold 322 pairs of socks with 24 teams participating, which is just amazing!! \$1700 of profit was raised on the day with \$850 going to each charity (Cancer Council and McGrath Foundation). This result is just awesome and shows such a huge club and community spirit! Thank you for everyone's support, we couldn't have done it without you. The smiling faces and pink everywhere is just so great to see. We also had quite a lot of support from other clubs which is just amazing!

We've had plenty of Coaches accredited this year, giving our players a greater coaching experience and by early 2019 we will have three Goal Keeper Coaches in the club.

Amongst all the thankyou's and congratulations, we also have some sadness. Late last year we lost two special people from the Richmond Family. Amanda Kinnell sadly passed away after a fight with Breast Cancer. Amanda was the very organised Manager of the U7 Pink Cougars for three years. Another long-time member Roger Hodgkins (husband of Judy, who is a Life Member and served for over 20years), also passed away last year. Roger had been a Manager, Committee Member, Parent and Grandparent for some time, and was our handyman around the park back in his day, building, amongst other things, the pigeon holes we still use now to make life easier for everyone. Roger was always around to help.

In early 2018 we lost a founding member, Mrs Shirley Baczynskyj (now Smallwood) from our life member ranks, one of whom we offer gratitude as one of the first committee, who, along with then husband Andy, and the first President, were instrumental in the organisation it took to get the Richmond ExSSC up and running, and of which we benefit today. COOPER – this kid has a big kick and his aim is improving with every game. His kick-ins are awesome and he is always thirsty to learn more. **Great job Cooper!**


HAYDEN – has come out of his shell over the last few weeks of the season, getting more involved in the play every game. **Awesome work Hayden!**
